2. Outreach Report—Unit Director, Ben Watson

The Lincoln Commission on Human Rights held their annual conference on April 19, 2023, where we had a table setup for outreach.

3. Director's Report – Executive Director, Paula Gardner

Director Gardner notified the Commissioners we have hired a new investigator for the Lincoln office, Hannah Liberator, who started on April 10, 2023. She comes to us from the civil rights division of Nebraska Department of Transportation, so it is a good match for everyone.

Direct Gardner mentioned at this time that since the last meeting, the agency has lost a housing investigator to a federal position. Along with that, recently an Omaha investigator has also resigned due to her significant other being relocated to Florida. Interviews will be conducted for the open positions, and she keep the commissioners updated.

As mentioned last meeting, Lexi George has filled the Office Specialist position in Lincoln.

Director Gardner noted staff has been working on streamlining the notification process for Commission meetings. Director Gardner explained the old process, emphasizing how much time and work was needlessly being put into it. She also indicated that the new process will also help the agency be more efficient if there is a need to cancel a Commission meeting on short notice.

Director Gardner announced that agency is on track to meet our goal for the HUD contract, that is through the end of June. HUD likes to have goals for agencies who they partner with that is based on population, and we are above the goal from where we were last year at this time. And despite the many recent turnovers, we are looking to be on track, or close to on track, for our EEOC contract as well.
